OUTDOOR ROLL-UP SHADES: DIRECTIONS TO INSTALL, USE AND MAINTAIN

HOW TO INSTALL

- 1. Determine mounting height of panels.
 - Mark height of panel on the surface by stretching full length of panel to the top.
- 2. Mount L-bracket to support the wooden rod holding the top panel.
 - Screw in directly nail on holes of L bracket for wood-surfaces.
 - On concrete surface, a drill is required to put in tox case first, then screw in nail.
- 3. For ceiling mounted panels (or if inside a cove), wood rod can directly be screwed in. No need for an L-bracket.

OPTIONAL

- 4. Install cord brackets on any side of panels.
 - Cord brackets are where cords can be coiled when panel is raised.
- 5. Install ground brackets on the ground or sides of panel.
 - Ground brackets keep the panel in placed during strong winds.
 - Additional string could be attached at hem of panel for the ground brackets.

HOW TO OPERATE

- 1. To move to desired length, simply pull-out cords.
- 2. To lock, tie cords at cord brackets or any nearby post.

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

- 1. Gently bring down and raise bamboo panels.
 - Never drag as this will put weight and pressure on top mounting.
- 2. Raise panels during times of storms (signal number 3) or strong winds.
- 3. Bring down panels at the end of a heavy down pour to dry.
 - Accumulated moisture or water in the inner sides of the roll ca or weaving.
- 4. Remove obstructions such as branches of trees, fallen leaves or other sharp objects near the panels. These may puncture the sticks or weaken the strands.
- 5. Protect from molds and fungi by brushing up with Leadrite 25 Fungicide Wood Preservative or Woodtec 2.5 EC once a year.
